Assisting the Teacher of the Deaf in all preschool activities including but not limited to: Supporting classroom routines, transitions, and instructional goals; management and checking of assistive listening devices; facilitating play and social interactions with peers during class and at recess; helping with student management; participation in toileting routines and toilet training; assisting with individualized records keeping and data collection of pre-academic skills; materials preparation and small group activity management.
